also externed for Judge Robert S. Lasnik of the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington and prosecuted misdemeanors as a Rule 9 legal intern with the King County Prosecutor's Office.

Before attending law school, Caleb graduated *summa cum laude* from Whitworth University where he played four years of college football, helping lead the Pirates to their first NCAA playoff appearance in nine years as a starting member of the team's nationally ranked defense and earning back-to-back academic all-district honors.
