BIOGRAPHY

Daron is an associate in the firm's Energy, Environment, and Infrastructure practice. Daron settled numerous cases with complex injunctive relief, including with the largest municipal wastewater treatment plant west of the Mississippi River, and several other industrial facilities throughout California, Hawaii, Arizona, and the Territory of Guam. On the counseling side, Daron primarily worked on underground injection control permits, including several Class I non-hazardous and Class VI carbon sequestration permits. Before joining the EPA, Daron served as an Assistant Corporation Counsel at the New York City Law Department where he would handle Section 1983 cases from complaint to trial. In addition to securing two complete defense verdicts at trial, Daron filed multiple motions to dismiss, motions for summary judgment, motions to compel, and participated in extensive discovery.

Daron graduated from Fordham University School of Law. During his time in law school, he was a staff member on the Fordham Urban Law Journal and a Brendan Moore Trial Advocate.
