BCLP ADVISES CAISSE D'EPARGNE CEPAC AND BPIFRANCE ON €125M FINANCING OF SOLAR ENERGY PRODUCER APEX ENERGIES

BCLP advises Caisse d'Epargne CEPAC and Bpifrance in connection with the financing of approximately €125 million in senior debt subscribed by Apex Energies.

This financing will support the construction of 250 rooftop and shaded solar power plants by mid-2025, representing a total capacity of 70 MWp.

The assets will be part of the Acacia portfolio, which will ultimately comprise more than 400 solar power plants in total.
