Shy's session on 4 September will focus on "*The Collaboration Playbook: How Successful Projects Adopt a Partnership Mindset to Achieve On Time, On Target, On Profit Projects.*" Shy, along with the other panellists, will discuss the benefits of collaborative contracting, the NEC4 contracts and how a partnership approach ensures a win-win situation for every partner in the construction value chain.

In 2024, the whole of IBEW is expected to attract some +10,000 attendees and delegates from across the global built environment community.
