## ASSOCIATE AUTHORS NEW CHAPTER FOR NY ZONING LAW LEGAL TREATISE

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BCLP Associate Kurt Steinhouse recently authored a new chapter in the latest edition of the legal treatise, *New York Zoning Law and Practice*. This edition contains significant organizational changes and substantive updates for practitioners. Over the years, this treatise continues to be the most widely cited authority by courts and practitioners in the field of land use law in New York.

Chapter 12, "Zoning and Land Use in New York City," in *New York Zoning Law and Practice* (5<sup>th</sup> Edition, 2024) focuses on the aspects of land use in New York City that make its regulatory environment unique from other municipalities in New York State with discussion of the various entities responsible for land use administration as well as overviews of the New York City Zoning Resolution, Uniform Land Use Review Procedure (ULURP), historic preservation, and City Environmental Quality Review (CEQR).
