BCLP Partner George Chen recently joined a panel discussion at the ABA Real Property Trust & Estate Law Section's Virtual CLE Conference, exploring the evolving landscape of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) following *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. Harvard* and *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. University of North Carolina*.

Titled "Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in the Aftermath of *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc.*," the panel provided an in-depth review of these landmark cases, related executive orders, and their ongoing impact on DEI efforts across the legal industry. George alongside fellow panelists discussed how law firms, corporations, and organizations are adapting, highlighting both existing initiatives and new approaches to support the current and future legal workforce.
